#### MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING:

010 Reviewed the Minutes of the Rally Advisory Panel meeting of 1<sup>st</sup> February 2012, noted.

#### BUSINESS ARISING FROM PREVIOUS MINUTES:

## **GENERAL BUSINESS:**

- 011 It was noted that CAMS Rally event schedule for 2012 is incorrect on the CAMS website. The QRC and Sportsman Series schedules need to be corrected. Jamie Macfarlane will notify Lisa at the CAMS office and to ask Lisa to advise Adrian Dillon who is currently registered for the QRC and Sportsman A and B series.
- 012 Barry Neuendorff briefed Panel regarding Mex Maintenance Software sponsorship of the QRC and Sportsman series and their potential involvement in Camp Crystal. Mex have been offered a corporate ride day at IROQ by Errol Bailey. The CAMS logo will be added to the windscreen banners for QRC and Sportsman Series competitors. Mex to provide the artwork to RAP to arrange for printing. Mex will prepare a press release for publication in Club magazines etc to announce their involvement as naming rights sponsor for the 2012 QRC and Sportsman Series. Stephen Davies raised the question of where an event sponsor can place their advertising on competing vehicles given the windscreen is taken by Mex. It was generally agreed that the Event Sponsors should have the area on the bonnet; to be nominated in the supplementary regulations for each event. When a vehicle is entered in an event and the crew are not registered to score points in the QRC or Sportsman Series, the supplementary regulations may require the placement of a MEX windscreen banner either on the windscreen or the bonnet of said car.
- 013 Discussion regarding traffic control officers (TCO). Sponsorship monies from Mex is proposed to put toward training and licensing of TCOs. Steve Davies reported that the requirements in New South Wales are different to those of Queensland and this will affect the Border Ranges Rally. Further investigation to be carried out by John Keen and Barry Neuendorff.
- 014 Barry Neuendorff briefed the panel on progress with Queensland Transport regarding C plate registration. Correspondence to Barry from John Bruning (Senior Manager of Sport and Club Development in CAMS) is that we have gone as far as we can and will have to wait for QLD Transport's next move. Due to the impending state elections, this is on hold. Barry to follow up post election.

## **CORRESPONDENCE:**

- 015 Email received from John Black re: seeking to have a separate class for P1 as opposed to the current amalgamation of P1 & P2 in the 2012 Queensland Rally Handbook. This was discussed at great length and agreed to leave the status quo.

**Chairman's note:** Subsequent to the RAP meeting, I have received advice of an impending CAMS Bulletin covering the amalgamation of classes, the content of which means the 2012 Qld Rally Handbook will need to be amended to comply with that bulletin, and taken to QSC for ratification on 20/03/2012.

## **GENERAL BUSINESS:**

- 016 Paul Woodward advised that the KCF Rallysport Kenilworth rally has a proposed rescheduled date of 27<sup>th</sup> October 2012. This is to be confirmed and ratified at QSC. It was also noted that the BSCC event scheduled for 1<sup>st</sup> September at Bli Bli is not likely to run as the land has been sold.

- 017 Panel acknowledges and thanks Steve Andrews for creating the artwork for the QRC fifty years logo which will be used on the windscreen banner and literature promoting the QRC and Sportsman Series in 2012. Jamie Macfarlane to write to Steve thanking him for his efforts.
- 018 Panel received a nomination for Panel member from Gary Mitchell. Panel members recommend the nomination and will forward it to QSC for consideration.
