MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING:

018 The minutes from the previous meeting held on 4th March 2015 were accepted as a true and accurate record.

BUSINESS ARISING FROM PREVIOUS MINUTES:

019 Ian Menzies (Qld ARCom Commissioner) gave the Panel an update on the new Commission structure and operations. Ian also gave an update on the Qld Rally Registration scheme and discussed the implementation of CAMS FHR requirements and other safety issues. Panel Chair thanked Ian for his input and invited him to remain for the rest of the meeting.

- 020 Ref. RAP15.010 - Rally Car Registration Scheme
Panel noted that CAMS has advised that the implementation of the Scheme is on track and undertook to keep Panel Chair informed. Ian Menzies mentioned that any enquiries about the Scheme should come to him or Panel Chair as Scott McGrath had been receiving many questions and this was delaying his work on finalising the Scheme with TMR.
- 021 Ref. RAP15.014 - Video of the 2015 QRC
Justin Northage gave an update on the work he did at Rally New England with media reports etc. This approach can apply to QRC rounds and the requirements (including funding through sponsorship) were discussed. Panel agreed to assist in the facilitation of improved social media activity for QRC rounds but the Panel agreed it will not be the provider of that service. Matt Sosimenko agreed to send Justin details on entry numbers in recent QRC events to help Justin compile data for articles and videos.
- 022 Ref. RAP15.013 - Rally of Kyogle (QRC 5)
Panel was advised that due to a number of circumstances relating to Council approvals and other permits not having been sought in time for the running of QRC 5 (Rally of Kyogle), that event cannot be developed and run in 2015. Panel noted this advice and agreed that BSCC consider an option to run an event in Jimna on the allocated date of 15/16 August 2015. The BSCC Board will consider this option and Panel will be advised. This may have an effect on the running of QRC 6 in November, but that will be part of any report to Panel at the next meeting.

- 023 Sharyn Cooke (CAMS Qld Office) advised Panel of a proposal by the Whitsunday Sporting Car Club to invite experienced QRC competitors to come to the Club and assist in the conduct of a training camp to support those club members that are aspiring to run in forest rallies and eventually the QRC. Panel supported this idea and asked for more information to be sent to Panel to allow planning to occur.
- 024 Peter Marcovich circulated a "safety pamphlet" used in WA ARC round for team, officials, spectator and service crew safety. Peter is to get details of any copyright or agreements needed for a similar document to be developed for use in Qld events.
- 025 Clay Weston gave an update on QRC 2 at Wowan. It has new stages and all Permits are in place.
